Masinyusane is filled with excitement and pride as we reach the midpoint of 2024. We are thrilled to share that the first half of this year has been nothing short of incredible. We recently completed our midyear assessments, and the results are fantastic—our children are making tremendous progress!

As you'll see in the rest of this report, our work continues to expand and deepen. We are now actively engaged in 69 preschools (ECDCs) and 42 primary schools across the Eastern Cape of South Africa. Our commitment to both literacy and math remains strong, and the positive impact on the children we serve is clear.

Our team of dedicated young coaches—who themselves are products of these communities—are at the heart of this success. They bring essential literacy, numeracy, and storytelling support to local schools, helping to build a solid educational foundation for each child.

Our data-driven approach ensures that every intervention is effective and scalable, focusing on customizing our intervention for each child (often referred to as Teaching at the Right Level). The results below speak for themselves. Our children learn to read twice as fast as control groups.

We also published our new <u>Data Portal</u> this quarter. It's designed to showcase our successes (and struggles!), provide transparency, and ensure we are held accountable. By openly sharing our data, we aim to provide you with a clear view of how your support is transforming lives.

We continue to provide opportunities for young people to grow, learn, and uplift their communities. We have created jobs for over 300 young people in 2024, over ninety percent of which are women. With every step forward, we are more determined than ever to build a brighter future for South Africa's children and youth.

As we look ahead to the rest of the year, we are excited to continue this journey of transformation, knowing that together, we are changing lives and building a better South Africa for all.

South Africa possesses one of the highest youth unemployment rates in the world. 






Every Child Deserves

Nobel Prize-winning economist James
Heckman's research has shown that the greatest
return on investment for a society is in early childhood
development. His work demonstrates that investing in
quality early childhood programs can yield a 13% per
year return on investment through better outcomes in
education, health, sociability, economic productivity, and
reduced crime.

By focusing on early childhood literacy and numeracy, while also creating employment opportunities for community youth, our project is leveraging the power of early intervention to drive long-term, sustainable change.






Meet Limokuhle

Zanothando, only 5 years old, has made huge strides this year and is already reading short stories with her literacy coach.





2. Primary School Literacy



Masinyusane fosters primary school literacy by providing tailored sessions focused on reading, writing, and comprehension skills over 4-5 years. Our core literacy program consistently outperforms control groups by 40-50% annually, with long-term participants showing even greater advancement. By cultivating proficient readers, we equip children with lifelong learning tools, opening doors to limitless opportunities for their futures.

3. Zazi Izandi

In 2023, we partnered with the government and leading organizations to expand our program into more schools. achieving astounding results: teaching as many letter sounds in 6 weeks as children typically learn in a year. Building on this success in 2024, we're scaling the initiative nationwide.

4. 1000 Stories

Stories are life changing. Our 1,000 stories programme seeks to ensure every child has heard at least 1.000 stories before age 7. On top of that, we build libraries and send tens of thousands of books into our children's

Anelisa is, for the second consecutive year, one of our Top 5 performing literacy coaches. She works at Sinethemba Creche, an informal wooden shack packed with 45 children.

What she has accomplished with her children is absolutely astounding. Her children, who all come from extreme poverty, came into the year scoring zero's on all of our metrics.

In just six months, they have nearly mastered all of their phonetic awareness skills and tearing through their letter knowledge and phonics.

She is single-handedly ensuring her children become little readers.
